IMMEDIATE RELEASE BAKERSFIELD-DELANO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Kern County)

The unemployment rate in Kern County was 9.6 percent in June 2025, up from a revised 8.7 percent in May 2025, and above the year-ago estimate of 9.0 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.7 percent for California and 4.4 percent for the nation during the same period.
