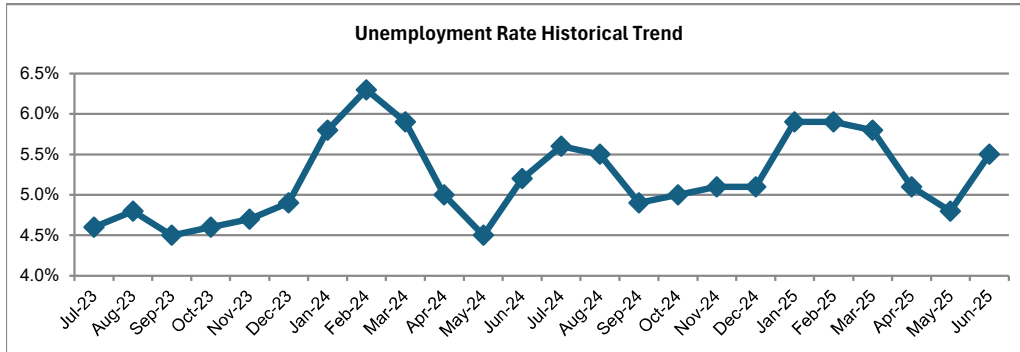


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
REDDING METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(Shasta County)

The unemployment rate in Shasta County was 5.5 percent in June 2025, up from a revised 4.8 percent in May 2025, and above the year-ago estimate of 5.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.7 percent for California and 4.4 percent for the nation during the same period.
