(RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES)****Nonfarm employment down 100 over the month and up 17,700 over the year**

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 5.9 percent in June 2025, up from a revised 4.8 percent in May 2025, and above the year-ago estimate of 5.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.7 percent for California and 4.4 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 6.0 percent in Riverside County, and 5.9 percent in San Bernardino County.

**Between May 2025 and June 2025**, total nonfarm employment decreased from 1,706,200 to 1,706,100, a decrease of 100 jobs. Agricultural employment increased by 600 jobs.

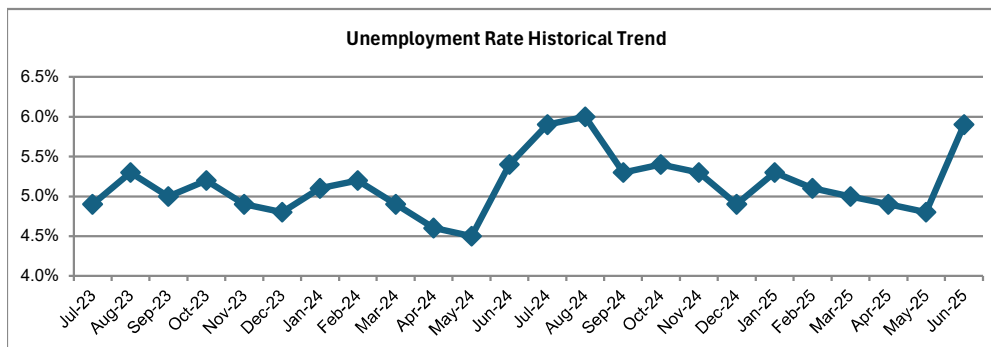
- Professional and business services (down 2,400) lost the most jobs over the month. Most of the decline registered in administrative and support and waste management and remediation services (down 2,100). Professional, scientific, and technical services lost 300 jobs, while management of companies and enterprises remained unchanged, completing the overall sectoral decline. Two other sectors declined over the month: trade, transportation, and utilities (down 900) and private education and health services (down 600). Four other sectors remained unchanged, including mining and logging, and information.
- Construction added the most jobs over the month (up 1,700). Specialty trade contractors (up 1,100) added the most jobs within the sector, followed by job additions in construction of buildings (up 300), and heavy and civil engineering construction (up 300).
- Government added 1,100 jobs over the month. All the job increases registered in local government (up 1,400). State government offset job expansion with a decline of 300 jobs. Federal government remained unchanged. Two other sectors increased over the month, including leisure and hospitality (up 900).

**Between June 2024 and June 2025**, total nonfarm employment increased by 17,700, a 1.0 percent change. Agricultural employment decreased by 600 jobs or 4.1 percent.

- Private education and health services gained the most jobs over the year, adding 18,200 jobs. Most of the job expansion registered in health care and social assistance (up 15,800). Private educational services added 2,400 jobs, completing overall sector gains.
- Government increased by 11,600 jobs. Local government added 12,800 jobs, while losses in state government (down 700) and federal government (down 500) offset sectoral job gains. Two other sectors gained jobs over the year, including trade, transportation, and utilities (up 1,000).
- Construction declined by 5,200 jobs. Specialty trade contractors (down 3,900) lost the most jobs within the sector. Construction of buildings declined by 900 jobs, followed by losses in heavy and civil engineering construction (down 400). Six other sectors declined over the year, including leisure and hospitality (down 3,400) and manufacturing (down 2,800).
