(916) 931-9599**SAN FRANCISCO-SAN MATEO-REDWOOD CITY METROPOLITAN DIVISION (SAN FRANCISCO AND SAN MATEO COUNTIES)****Professional and business services led month-over job increases and year-over decreases.**

The unemployment rate in the San Francisco-San Mateo-Redwood City MD was 4.2 percent in June 2025, up from a revised 3.5 percent in May 2025, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.8 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.7 percent for California and 4.4 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.2 percent in San Francisco County, and 4.1 percent in San Mateo County.

**Between May 2025 and June 2025**, the total number of jobs in the San Francisco-San Mateo-Redwood City MD, which includes the counties of San Francisco and San Mateo, increased by 4,000 jobs to total 1,144,000 jobs.

- Professional and business services (up 1,600 jobs) saw the largest month-over gain. The most growth was seen in professional, scientific, and technical services (up 1,700), followed by management of companies and remediation services (up 100), whereas administrative and support and waste management and remediation services trimmed 200 jobs.
- Construction boosted employment by nearly 3.7 percent, or 1,400 jobs since May. Specialty trade contractors (up 700 jobs) and construction of buildings (up 600) were the bulk of this uptick.
- Leisure and hospitality (up 900 jobs) continued to increase hiring in preparation for the summer season. Additions were divided between accommodation and food services (up 500) and arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 400).
- Other major industry gains included: information (up 500 jobs), other services (up 400), and manufacturing (up 300).
- Meanwhile, government cut 700 positions and private education and health services shed 500 more due to the seasonal school year recess.

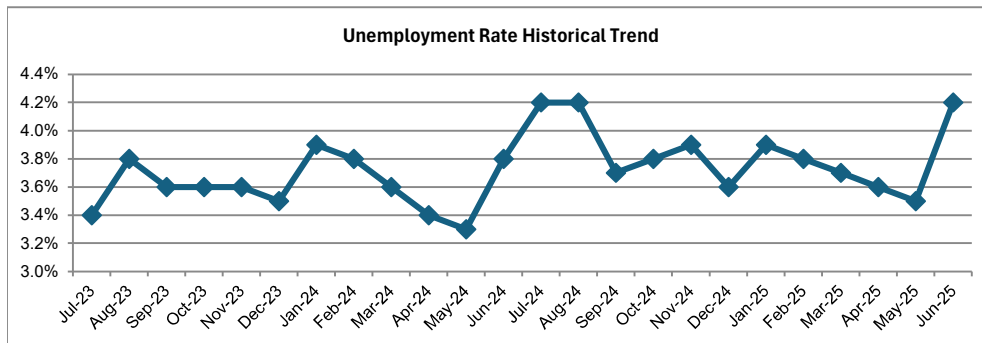
**Between June 2024 and June 2025**, the total number of jobs in the counties of San Francisco and San Mateo decreased by 6,200 jobs, or 0.5 percent.

- Professional and business services (down 3,300 jobs) remained down as it led year-over decline. Despite the added jobs in administrative and support and waste management and remediation services (up 2,900), losses in professional, scientific, and technical services (down 5,900) and management of companies and enterprises (down 300) resulted in a total net decrease.
- Information followed closely by deducting 3,200 jobs from its payroll.
- Financial activities experienced a fall of 2,200 jobs. Finance and insurance (down 1,700 jobs) accounted for approximately 77 percent of the reduction.
- Conversely, private education and health services (up 2,900 jobs) reported the highest year-over expansion. The improvement in health care and social assistance (up 3,400) was slightly offset by the dip in private educational services (down 500).
